This is the skull of a Saltwater Crocodile.
It can eat large prey like wallabies and cows.



Saltwater crocodiles like saltwater
and will swim close to shore.



Saltwater crocodiles can live in the ocean for a long time.



Saltwater crocodiles like freshwater.



Saltwater crocodiles live in big rivers
and deep waterholes.

Saltwater crocodiles live in small waterholes and shallow water.



Saltwater crocodiles may be bigger than your boat.



Don't sit in the river, stay away from crocodiles!

Saltwater crocodiles can leave the water if their waterhole dries up.



Saltwater crocodiles can leave the water if they smell food.



Always camp at least 50 metres away from the water.



Saltwater crocodiles can leap out of the water to catch prey.



Stay at least five metres back from the water while fishing from the edge.



Always Be Crocwise when you are around boat ramps.
